

Activity-01

Make compost in a bottle by following given instructions.

- First cut around the neck of the bottle to form a wider neck hole.
- Add a layer of garden soil to the bottom of your bottle around 2-centimetre 24 centimetre deep this introduces the bacteria needed to make black nutritious compost.
- Next add a layer of peeling any things (fruit and vegetable peels) from leftover.
- Add another layer of each to your bottle.
- Finally add another layer of soil and a layer of grass or leaves. You can repeat this layering pattern until your bottle is full.
- Now your bottle is ready. Tape the top of your bottle close to keep the moisture in.
- Now just place your pot in a warm sunny place let the magic begin.
- Approx 3 weeks you will see a big change in the contents of the bottle and your compost will be ready.
